Trachelospermum Jasminoides

Commonly known as 'Star Jasmine' because of the attractive star shaped flowers.

A vigorous woody evergreen climber that produces masses of highly scented white flowers throughout the late spring and early summer.

Can be trained across fences and arches to create a stunning feature.

Needs to be planted in full sun, in a sheltered position in well-drained soil.

Feed with a granular feed in the autumn and keep well-watered throughout the year, particularly in dry and/or windy conditions.

Eventual Height and Spread: 4m x 8m
